The [regional project](#) was launched in 2016 to support the newly established Russia-UNDP partnership and Trust Fund for Development by promoting innovations and knowledge sharing between Russia and partner countries.

Funding the participation of Russian experts in international events focused on the SDGs

Funding is provided for the participation in events on sustainable development issues organized outside of Russia. The KM project covers:



Economy air tickets

Purchased by UNDP (the cost of tickets purchased by experts is not covered!)



Daily subsistence allowance (DSA)

The DSA covering accommodation and meals is paid based on the UN rate

Terminals

\$63 (x4) to cover transportation costs to and from the airport in both directions



Registration fees

The project reimburses the registration fee, paid and confirmed by the expert, after the event

Who can apply?

Experts registered in the [Database of Russian experts for international development](#)

Participant report

Experts shall provide written reports with photos within 5 working days after the event takes place

Report should include:

- 1) Title, date and location of the event
- 2) Topic and talking points, discussion results
- 3) [SDGs](#) related to the topic
- 4) At least 3 photos, including expert's presentation with audience and with other participants in front of the event's press wall

Application procedure



Application should be submitted by e-mail at least 1.5 months before the event to: elena.smirnova@undp.org and natalia.voronkova@undp.org



Application should contain:

1. Full name, position, place of work, link to the profile in the [Database of Russian experts](#), information about participation in international projects
2. Title, contact information of event organizers, the event web page, programme, date and location of the event
3. Topic of the expert's presentation



Application should include:

- Talking points (a PowerPoint presentation or relevant publications)
- Event programme
- Personal invitation letter from event organizers to be a speaker

• **Request for funding** duly completed and signed
